Drama

The Course

- is studied in Year 7 every week and every cycle in Year 8
- looks at the drama process as well as the final product
- improves performance skills by allowing students to perform their own work and recreate written texts

During Key Stage 3 students will cover a wide range of topics:

Year 7

- introduction to script
- script work – directing and performing
- Genre, style and conventions
- Brecht (Practitioner 1)

Year 8

- Stanislavski (Practice 2)
- Script work (Realism)
- Stimulus

Assessment

Takes place throughout the course every half term and involves Peer and Teacher assessment of both practical and theory based elements.
