The Governors of The Hessle Academy have a clear Uniform Policy for Penshurst Primary School. The clearly defined policy requires all pupils to wear the approved school uniform when at school and to any school function where it is considered appropriate.

The wearing of uniform enables the children to feel a sense of pride and belonging to their school community. The wearing of uniform also gives clear expectations to ensure health and safety and a good working environment are maintained. In addition, the inclusive ethos of the school places a high priority on equality.

The Governors have arrived at the Uniform Policy through consultation and it is reviewed regularly. We acknowledge that school uniform is a significant investment for parents and we endeavour to ensure that as, primary school age children rapidly outgrow their clothes, that our uniform is simple and available largely from good retailers.

The school will make every effort to apply the uniform policy consistently and parents should expect to be challenged by school leaders where this is not the case.

Compulsory items are bolded and are available through our uniform provider, Rawcliffes Schoolwear, Paragon Street, Hull, HU1 3RJ are of the highest quality and best value.

V neck Jumper Round neck Sweatshirt Cardigan	Green with school logo
Polo Shirt	White Logo polo shirt available at Rawcliffes
Skirt Trousers/Shorts	Grey or black. Pinafore dresses are acceptable
School Tie – Year 6 only	Green tie with yellow stripe Available from Rawcliffes
Dress	A green checked summer dress may be worn in the summer term ONLY
Shoes	Sensible black shoes No heeled shoes or flip flops
Book Bag	For use every day to carry school reading book and reading log home each day. Logo book bag available at Rawcliffes

Indoor PE T-Shirt	House colour with logo
Shorts	Black
Leotard	For dance or gym
Plimsolls	It is expected that dance/gym will be done in bare feet. However, suitable plimsolls will be accepted
Footwear	Appropriate footwear dependant on the activity, but may include trainers and football boots
Tracksuit	Optional for cold weather of a dark colour (black or navy)
Shin pads	MUST be worn for football
Drawstring PE Bag	To safely store PE kit on the peg. For the Health and Safety reasons only drawstring bags will be allowed in school

Jewellery	One small pair of metal studs may be worn, but NO other items of jewellery. Earrings must be removed for PE
Hairstyles	Should be of broadly even length, no shaved patterns. Mohican styles are not permitted. Hair should be of a natural colour. Hair accessories should be of school colours (grey, white, green or black) and of an appropriate size
Make-up	Must not be worn in school

Pupils will be seen by their class teacher in the morning and issues of uniform addressed then. The school reserves the right to determine whether items of clothing/uniform are appropriate for school.
