

International Elite Sportsperson / Ancillary Sportsperson Exemption Instructions to applicants

It is important that you read these instructions carefully as any incorrect information may void the application.

As the national governing body we will be required to confirm your status as an international elite sportsperson / international ancillary sportsperson who has travelled to a non-exempt country or territory to participate in an elite sports event, and that you will be continuing those activities on your return.

Specifically, you will not need to self-isolate, but you should observe the Stages One to Four elite sport guidance framework as published by the UK government.

To consider and approve your application for an exemption letter, Motorsport UK will require:

1. Your full name as stated on your passport
2. Your residential address
3. Your Competition number/if none then your position
4. Your team and manager contact details
5. The dates you wish to travel including the competitions you will be travelling to in the next month (specified competitions).

Requests are reviewed on a monthly basis and any further travel beyond September will need to be through further application to us.

The exemption letter only entitles you to undertake your period of self-isolation upon arrival in the UK at their residential address and attend the relevant training centre/circuit and travel to and from the specified competitions.

It is your duty to ensure you protect yourself and those around you and it is therefore strongly advised on each return to and from specified competitions that you seek to get tested for coronavirus.

Exemption letters are only applicable to international elite sportsperson or international ancillary sportsperson and will not be valid for family or friends.
